

Our Lady of Divine Providence Family: Parish Donations Data by Age

September 26, 2024

The following information is data recently collected and to be analyzed by the Family Leadership Team and the Beacons Planning Council of Our Lady of Divine Providence (OLODP) Family of Parishes. Fr. Umberg is referring to this information in his recorded message this weekend of September 28-29. These tables reflect Sunday Mass donations (and regular electronic donations, as well as yearly donations) for each parish for the past three fiscal years by age groups of donors. Note that the Archdiocesan fiscal year runs from July 1–June 30.

You will note that the majority of our collection income is from those over 65 years of age, and there is not as much money coming in from all the younger age groups combined (not even close). This will give you an idea of how the parishes in our Family are trending financially and how donors are aging. No names of any donors were revealed in this process, only ages. Data from Mother of Christ was not included since it is a very small community and now officially determined to be a “mission” of St. Bernard Parish.
